He played basketball on any pick-up team he'd find, at St. Bede, Marist High School and achieved a Division 1 Athletic Scholarship for basketball at Samford University in Birmingham, Alabama. Playing D-1 basketball was his lifelong ambition, and this Chicago Southside Irish Catholic boy proudly moved down South to fulfill his dream. His dream was cut short during his senior year on Tuesday, September 8, 2009, when he quietly passed away in his sleep. There were no symptoms, but his heart had an undetectable defect. His passing shocked and saddened all who knew him.

Anyone who knew Jimmy knew that he was much more than basketball. He was full of fun, life, and charm. He never had to be the center of attention, but people were drawn to him. He never let people be bullied in his presence; he stood up for what was right, even if it wasn't the popular thing to do. His friends came in all shapes and sizes and were not necessarily the best athletes or the smartest in the class - that never mattered to Jimmy. He was a friend to all.



The Griffin family is determined that this wonderful young man's life and legacy will never be forgotten. WHO Boys/girls and men/women in 5th grade through adult. NO co-ed teams. Players may bring their own team of 3 or 4 or get assigned to a team.
TEAMS ALL Divisions may bring their own team of 3 or 4 players. Divisions will be 5/6th grade, 7/8th grade, 9-12 grade and adults. Only one registration form needed for a full-team registration. (All players must still have waivers.)
REGISTRATION DEADLINES 5/6 grades register by 9:45 a.m., play begins at 10:30. 7/8 grades register by 10:30 a.m., play begins approx 11:30. Grades 9-12 register by 11:30 a.m., play begins approx 12:30. Adults register by 12:30 p.m., play begins around 1:15. ALL PLAYERS MUST BE REGISTERED BY DEADLINE TIMES IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE.
